With the split in opinions regarding the scope and application of the California Rule in the *Marin* and *Alameda* cases, the California Supreme Court has agreed to hear appeals of both. While these two cases, and another pending before the Court – *Cal Fire* — all center around changes made by Assembly Bills 340 and 197 in late 2012, commonly referred to as PEPRA, the implications of a ruling by the State's high court could be significant. 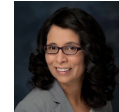
